Safety & Emergency Code + Travel Notice

This information is important. Please read it carefully and thoroughly. Any inconvenience occurs from missing the information provided below will be individuals' risk and responsibility.

SAFETY CODE. Participant should make preparedness of personal gear, apparel and auxiliaries to ease their own comfort and safety. And quit before the limit of capacity or skill when facing danger or risk. Prudently follow all Guide-Trip Leader safety and trip instruction, as ORGANIZER will take every necessary measure and prevention to avoid danger and risk.

MEDIC & EMERGENCY. Medic crews are provided to escort the participant en-route, and to assist in case of emergency. All participants taking part on this Trip are assumed to be in good health and best condition, but if there is any sickness suffered, please inform our Medic crew for prevention and emergency medication. General drug and minor emergency kit are provided under responsibility of our Medic crew. Please bring your personal drug and medicine, either than prohibited one by law.

BOAT TRIP. In some areas, we will utilize a wooden traditional boat as transportation mode. The boat designed in accordance with local custom, river - lake condition, and normally utilized for local transportation of goods, commodities and people. ORGANIZER will provide sufficient life vest in various size, to increase safety factor during boat trip and while enjoy swimming-snorkeling Trip.

CHILDREN. Children and family participation encouraged in this festive, no more priceless than family. Children participation shall be under custody and full responsibility of their parent(s). All gear, outfit and preparedness shall be provided at their comfort. ORGANIZER will do their best to facilitate their attendance. ORGANIZER will provide sufficient number of children size life vest to be worn during the trip.

CATERING & COOKING. During the Trip, participants will enjoy local catering and cuisine, cooked under ORGANIZER's supervisory. Only HALAL food would be served, as mostly fresh seafood, vegetables and fruit are the main ingredients. No western style meal would be served. Participants may bring simple cooking apparatus to cook extra favorite cooking.

ACCOMODATION & ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERN. All participants and ORGANIZER crew will mostly stay in local accomodation with a limited facilities, backpacking style. Therefore traveling gear is required; sleeping bag and mattress. There is no bathroom in the Jungle, for women, it is recommended to bring sarong (traditional bathwear for women) to bath in the river. Clean water not supplied in abundance, but adequate. Be wise and do mutual respect on others

All participant shall obey environmental concern policy taken for this Trip. No litter of garbage to the sea, boats or islands during the trip, all participants shall collect own rubbish in plastic bag, and to be collected from time to time by our crew. Respect nature, respect others, and respect your selves.

Some of places are nature sanctuary zone. Basically, only scientific research, limited human activities and touch allowed in this area. ORGANIZER remind all Participants, to take any efforts and manner to obey LAW and ORDER on this heavily protected area. No leaf, branch, tree, animal-plant or other protected material may be disturbed or taken out from this area. Disobedience on this LAW and ORDER shall be own risk.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT & LOCAL VALUE RESPECT. Above and beyond this trip, we ask you to participate in community development activity by contributing used books/magazines. These books/magazines will be donated to local children and teenager in Dayak Taman dan Tekenang

community who deserve reading material. Minimum 2-5 used/new books required to be donated by each participant.

As our activity will get in touch with local people and community, all participants are required to take every measures to perform good manner and conduct in spoken and action, also to respect good local value and belief.

TIME, SCHEDULE AND PUNCTUALITY. All participants shall respect - by all means - on all time and schedule which are arranged and informed by ORGANIZER. Any delay and/or violation on this rule will affect on others comfort, disturbing the enjoyment of the Trip. Participants shall bear its own cost due to late or violation on this rule.

INSURANCE COVERAGE, RELEASE AND DISCHARGE TERMS. ORGANIZER will protect all participants, Media Crew and ORGANIZER crew with insurance policy from PT. Jasindo, from any accident and mortality happen due in this Trip as covered by the Policy stipulation. Personal property should be not included in this coverage. Owner/Participant should responsible from any damage, loss and risk for the period of the event, including during transportation by ORGANIZER. ORGANIZER will take all necessary common effort to avoid damage and loss during transportation.

Participant should fill-in the registration form in accordance with stipulation of ID/Passport identity, to facilitate claim if any in the future. All Participant should fully understood RELEASE AND DISCHARGE terms as stated and legalized in this event.

ESSENTIAL GEAR LISTING, please adjust with your own style and necessity :

- Sleeping bag and mattress as only backpacker style accommodation provided.
- Heavy duty trekking boots, and gaiters for foot - shoes protection
- Treeking sandal or slipper (sandal jepit), for relax session
- Solar protection: cap, sun glasses, sun block, arms second skin, simple hand clove, pashmina fabric, long sleeve shirt/T-Shirt. Quick dry type with UV protection recommended
- Outdoor/adventure style outfit and Jacket. Thick cloth is not necessary, as we are in tropical rain forest and equator area. Please bring 2 (two) pcs orange color T-Shirt as forest trekking wardrobe code.
- Toiletries
- Rain Coat or poncho. Organizer will provide one with event logo.
- Personal drug and medicine
- Your favorite snack and candy for your own
- Camera, Handy cam and auxiliaries :
 - Tripod, battery, extra battery & charger, empty memory or film/slide stock
- Timer, simple compass and praying apparatus (for Moslem)
- Head lamp (recommended!), mini torch.
- Swimming & snorkeling gear
